NOTIFICATION

ICSSR has decided to adopt Expenditure, Advance and Transfer (EAT) Module on the direction of Ministries of Finance and Human Resource Development, Government of India to ensure complete tracking of funds released and expenditure upto the last mile implementing agency, under all the schemes being implemented by the ICSSR.

All the implementing agencies of ICSSR Scheme, Central Sector Schemes will mandatorily use EAT Module with immediate effect failing which no further funds will be released to the agencies.

It is to take immediate actions on the following issues:

- Implementation of EAT module in Regional Centres / Universities / Institutions / Colleges funded by ICSSR be ensured w.e.f. FY 2019-20.
- Bank Account(s) registered under PFMS for ICSSR scheme (0877) will not be registered for any other funding agency. This Account(s) shall exclusively be used for ICSSR scheme only, failing which Council will not release any further grant to the beneficiary Institutions.
- Bank Account must be in the full name of the Institution, for eg. Jawaharlal Nehru University (ICSSR-0877).
- Implementing agencies who are already registered on PFMS need to add the Scheme Code 0877 and for funding agency, select ICSSR as funding agency (not Central Govt' or State Govt.) and inform us on mail id given below along with mandate form attached.

Both these needs to be duly certified by the Convener, Registrar/Principal, and the Finance Officer in case of the Central University or the Chartered Accountant in case of other institutions.

Kindly ensure that the Utilization Certificate and the Statement of Expenditure must be duly verified and properly stamped by the Principal/Registrar/Head of the Institution and the Finance Officer/Chartered Accountant as the case may be.

The above documents are mandatory requirement to settle the account and enable us to release the final installment.

The purpose is to encourage all the aspirant and working LIS professionals and to share the knowledge on a variety of topics: e-learning, swayam, open access, cloud computing, digital libraries, e-resources, metadata, emerging and new technologies etc. useful for academic libraries.

Dr. M.Pankaja, Lecturer in English invited the guests and seminar started with prayer by Dr.P.Maheswari, Lecturer in Statistics.

The inaugural ceremony of the seminar started with a Ganapathi sloka and Lingastakam prayer by Dr.P.Maheswari, Lecturer in Statistics.

Dr.Y.Nagaraja Naidu, President of the inaugural session presided over the function and welcomed all the delegates, Principals of other degree colleges, Library Professionals, Faculty members, research scholars and students to the seminar. He mentioned that the topic is relevant to the current situation and broad. He said that we are in the digital age and there is a gap between ancient libraries and modern libraries and this gap need to be filled. He felt that the students are not spending enough time for reading and we must accept it and need to change this trend. In his presidential address, he is mentioned that the new generation users are expecting the library services with in a short time and required the information access online. He is opined that most of the college libraries are in terrific condition. The libraries should provide best services to get good results and should guide the students in many aspects. He also revealed that this seminar will fulfil the needs of users and further it is useful to librarians, teachers and students. He said that the teacher and student relationship and bond is vert important for achieving academic excellence. He concluded with his best wishes to all the delegates' and for fruitful deliberations.

Dr. Nayakanti Maddaiah mentioned that the students are not turning up to the libraries regularly and not using library books, which is a big challenge. Dr. Maddaiah thanked the management for their support and expressed his gratitude to the Principal and other faculty members of the college. He opined that organising this seminar may provide a solution on how to attract more students to the libraries and access the information resources in innovative way. He opined that the government college libraries are buying text books only at present, hence reaching out the students is not an easy. He also felt that the lack of infrastructure is another challenge for the government colleges. The same will be discussed in this seminar.

Dr. M.R. Murali Prasad said that the students must consult the librarian for available resources in the library and to use the same for their education and research purpose. User perceptions and expectations are different and librarian must understand. He explained that the meeting students with librarian for their career growth and competitive exams are necessary. He

is mentioned that the librarian is a resource person and may guide the students in their career planning and helps in preparing competitive exams.

Dr. C. Mallikarjuna expressed his gratitude for sharing the dais first time with his research guide. He suggested all the students that they need to focus on fundamentals of science on the occasion of national science day. He stated that the libraries are shifting from print to digital media, which need more attention both by users and librarians. He suggested the library professionals to focus on the updated content and strengthen the libraries with quality collection.

Release of Seminar Volume with ISBN: Prof. K. Padmini, Principal SV College of Arts, SV University, Tirupati released the seminar proceedings volume edited along with Dr. Y. Nagaraja Naidu, Principal, SVA College (M), Sri Kalahasti, Dr. O. Sivasankar Prasad, Dy. Librarian, UoH and other editors Dr. Nayakanti Maddaiah, Dr.M.R. Murali Prasad and Dr. C. Mallikarjuna. The seminar volume is distributed to all the dignitaries on the dais.

Dr.T.Ramachandra Reddy revealed that the libraries are like temples. He also felt that principal, teaching staff, librarian, and director of physical education are the four pillars of any academic institution without them an achieving excellence is not possible. He said that this kind of organising seminar is rare. He complemented Prof. K. Padmini for her contribution in the LIS field and quoted that she works for the students without any personal interest. He also appreciated the organising secretary for organising this kind of seminar third in the same college. He also reminded the quote of Kandukuri Veeresalingam panthulu saying that chirigina chookka naina thodukko... oka manchi pustam konukko. He also stated that the gaining knowledge is important than obtaining marks in the exams.

Dr. C.S. Sukumar Reddy informed that the parents play a vital role in children career. He said that the academic libraries are prominent and support the curriculum and research of an organisation. He envisioned the type of libraries such as academic, public and special libraries and their impact on different users. He said that he is fond of reading telugu novels and at times read the same book again and again because of his interest in that particular book and which gives lot of satisfaction.

Dr. M. Bhaskar Reddy complemented the organizers. He enlightened the role and importance of library in NAAC and academic grades / rankings. He reminded the quote of Dr.

APJ Abdul Kalam One Best Book is equal to Hundred Good Friends, One Good Friend is equal to a Library. He is reiterated the various services and products of INFLIBNET to the students, research scholars and faculty and their use and impact. He is explained about e-consortiia, e-shodhganga, e-shodh sindu, e-shodh gangothri, NLIST, SOUL, anti-plagiarism softwares.

Dr. C. Sreeremulu said that the libraries need to do SWOT analysis and threats are big challenge for libraries. Cost benefit analysis is necessary for availing more grants from the authorities. He said that the library is a motivation and inspiration for many. Role of libraries in NAAC and RUSA is very important. He said that the government is developing many platforms for creating MOOCs, SWAYAM, NPTEL, EPG Pathasala and so on.

Prof. K. Padmini, Chief Guest of the Inaugural Session shared her experiences as a principal and recalled her mother and how she was when working as a Principal, she said that her spending of three decades in university is unforgettable. She said that she is blissful in sharing the dais her own research students who are working good positions. On this occasion she is appreciated the efforts of her students. She reminded her journey with the research scholars and their style of working. She motivated the young students with inspiring situations happened in her life. Also she expressed the main challenge of the day faced by many libraries is optimum utilization of the resources by the users. When most of the information is available through smart phones, users do not have much interest to visit libraries. It is the duty of the librarians to attract the users to the library with its ambiance, facilities, sources, services, and treatment. Some of the negative perceptions of the users must be cleared and expectations of the users must be taken care of. Hence, library must provide quality service in order to retain and increase its importance for its users and succeed in enhancing the role of the library in teaching, learning and research

The inaugural session was concluded with the Vote of thanks by Dr. M. Ananda Rao, Professor of Zoology, S.V.A. Government College (M), Srikalahasti.

Technical Sessions

Technical sessions were divided into six sessions spread over two days 28-29th February, 2020. There are 63 papers listed out of which 24 papers presented. There was a overwhelming response by the delegates who participated actively in the deliberations too. The following papers were presented in the first and second session.

28-02-2020 (First Day)

First Technical session was chaired by Dr. A. Durga Prasad, Lecturer in Library science, Librarian, NG College, Nalgonda and Co-chaired by Dr. G. Srinivasulu Reddy, Dept. of History, SVA Government College (M), Srikalahasti with following paper presentations

Dr. E. Sudhakar presented the paper entitled "Use And Awareness of Digital Library Resources by Faculty Members of Engineering College Libraries in Chittoor District: A Study". The paper highlighted user's survey of digital library resources available and its use and awareness to the faculty members working different colleges in Chittoor District. The findings are that majority of the faculty members using digital resources daily and collecting the same for subject information and for their teaching and research work. The paper also suggested that the more terminals should be installed for the benefit of the maximum faculty members and more funds should be given to acquire electronic resources. Apart from this, the internet bandwidth speed need to be increased for quick access of the available digital resources.

M. Swarnalatha presented the paper entitled "Awareness and Use of Institutional Repositories by Research Scholars In Sri Venkateswara University – A study". This paper discussed about user awareness and use of Institutional Repositories in Sri Venkateswara University. The paper touched upon various factors like type of materials contributing to the Institutional Repositories, training program in using IRs, problems facing in contributing to an IR. The authors have derived that the most of the users are aware of IRs and are interested to in contributing content to the IRs.

K. Eswaramma presented paper entitled "User Expectations and Information Seeking Behaviour in Digital Information Society: A Study in Government Degree Colleges in Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh". She discussed about the user expectations and their information seeking behaviour in digital information society. She narrated the characteristics of information such as timeliness, accuracy, relevance, and the importance of information. She also mentioned the various sources of information available both in physical and online formats.

Dr.P.Keshalu presented the paper entitles Impact of E-Resources in Oil Technological and Pharmaceutical Research Institute (OTPRI), Ananthapuram : A Case Study. He expressed his view about importance of e-resources usage by researchers regarding databases, open source sources, e-journals

B. Mallikarjuna Rao presented paper entitled "Usage of Social Networking tools by the Students of St.Peter's Engineering College (spec). Hyderabad. Telangana. He discussed the concepts of social networking tools and also highlighted the user survey results. He found that majority of the responded positively that the SNS are useful to find the relevant and updated information.

Second Technical session was chaired by Dr. K.Usha Rani, Asst. Professor, University Library, S.V. Veternary University, Tirupati and Co-chaired by K. Nagaraja, Lecturer in Library Science, Government Degree College, Naidupet with following paper presentations

B. Prasada Rao presented the paper entitled "Digital Pedagogy in LIS Education". This paper discussed the various digital pedagogy in LIS Education which includes social media, multimedia applications, cloud computing, Web 2.0, Web 3.0 tools. It defined digital pedagogy and explained the importance of digital pedagogy in education. It also confined the reasons for shifting from tradition pedagogy to digital pedagogy.

K. Nagaraju presented a paper awareness and use of SWAYAM course among LIS Professionals – A Study. He expressed his view with his presentation regarding online courses importance through SWAYAM using internet, computers and smart mobile.

Dr. O. Seshaiah presented the paper entitled "Web designing tools and techniques for library professionals". This paper discussed various web designing tools and techniques available for the library professionals. The author explained the importance of designing, hosting, and maintenance of library portal and anatomy of website. He further narrated the common web technologies and languages needed for developing library website. He also covered the concepts of graphic design tools, soft skills needed for web designers and, currently available open-source software's etc.,

Third Technical session was chaired by O.Shesaiah, Librarian, PBRVITS, Kavali and Co-chaired by E.Kiran Kumar, Lecturer in Library Science, Government Degree College, Gudur with following paper presentations

- **D. Muni Ushasree** presented the paper entitled "Andhra Pradesh Residential Junior College Lecturers' opinion on Library Facilities". This paper is evaluated the opinion of junior lectures regarding their library facilities, information resources and services. The analysis of the collected data covers the organisational setup of the library, library resources, and services. The most of the users are satisfied with the physical facilities and books available in the library.
- **B. Jayaramudu** presented the paper entitled "An overview of using cloud computing in libraries". This paper discussed the concepts of cloud computing and its use in libraries. It also covered characteristics, delivery models, and benefits with adopted libraries as examples.
- **Dr.Ch. Narayana Reddy** expressed in his presentations on entitled "Impact of social media on Library Professional Services in the Current Generation. Social media playing importance role in the society using through using whats aap, face book, twitter, blogs and linked in etc.
- **D. Vinod Kumar** were presented paper entitled Promotion of library resources and services using memes He discussed the promotion of Library Resources and services using new application Memes, how its useful for marketing library services, design and development of Memes and popular meme initiatives in libraries.

Second Day (29-02-2020)

Fourth Technical session was chaired by Dr.P.Keshalu, Lecturer in Library Science, PS Government Degree College, Penugonda and Co-chaired by Dr.N. Murali, Lecturer in Commerce, S.V.A. Government Degree College, Srikalahasti with following paper presentations

A. Durga Prasad presented the paper entitled "Emerging ICT applications in Library and Information Centers in Digital Era". This paper focused on emerging ICT applications in the library and information centres in digital era. He highlighted the different softwares available to use in academic libraries and ICT applications for library services.

Vijay Mahesh Kumar presented the paper entitled "Use of Social Media in Library Services". The article explored the phenomenon of use of social media in library services and further emphasised on various social media tools and their advantages. He asserted the some of the challenges such as privacy and personal data can easily be hacked and shared on the internet, users can create false account, time limit etc.

G. Srikanth presented the paper entitled "New trends and techniques for upcoming school library professionals: A case study of Glendale academy international school, Hyderabad". This paper tried to emphasised on new trends and techniques for upcoming school library professionals with a case study of Glendale Academy International School, Hyderabad. He also discussed the purpose of the school library. He touched upon the role of the school librarian in the modern days.

Dr. K. Lakshminarayana Reddy presented the paper entitled "Impact of 'SWAYAM' towards academic achievement". The author explained the impact of SWAYAM towards academic achievement. He narrated the background, MOOCs, scope, features, elements, issues and challenges of SWAYAM.

Baby Kunja presented the paper entitled "Community Information Services In Public Libraries: A Role on Telangana State". This paper deals with the role of public libraries in Community Information Services in Telangana State. She also mentioned the different types of Community Information Services provided by the public library. This paper further discussed the problem of providing CIS in Telangana state.

Fifth Technical session was chaired by Dr.K. Mahendra Rao, Lecturer in Library Science, Government Degree College, Kadiri and Co-chaired by Shoba Rani, Librarian, Sree Vdhyanikethan Engineering College, Tirupati with following paper presentations

Ammaji Rajitha was presented paper entitled Open source software for library automation in modern era: a study. She discussed the open source softwares available for the library ILMA, automation, digitisation, development of library websites and other tools. She touched upon the open source movement and different applications such as koha, newgenlib, evergreen, GSDL, DSpace, E-Prints, Fedora and Fedora Linux, Web Publishing..... Wordpress, Drupal etc.

Dr.D. Venkata Rao has presented a paper on User Expectations in Academic Libraries in digital information sources. He focused on user perceptions and expectations among users towards the library services, books arrangements, and digital information sources, e-journals, databases.

T. Ramachandra Naidu has presented a paper the impact of cloud computing made n library services to facilitate the genera public. He expressed in his presentation role of cloud computing transforming the information through cloud computing and library services and administration.

Fifth Technical session was chaired by Dr.D. Venkata Rao, Lecturer in Library Science, Jawahar Bharathi Degree College, Kavali and Co-chaired by G.Sreekanth, Librarian, Glendle International School, Hyderabad with following paper presentations

Niranjan has presented a paper Usage of E-Resources NAAC accredited selected Engineering College of Libraries of Warangal in Telangana State : A Study. He revealed is his paper bout usage and importance of e-resource towards ranking priority by NAAC.

Sreedhar Akuleti has presented a paper on Information needs and Information seeking behaviour of Sanscruthi school business students in puttaparthi : A Study. He focussed on his presentation about information need and information sources in to users in digital information society.

R. Deepika presented paper entitled Role of cloud computing in modern libraries. She discussed the role of cloud computing in modern libraries, what materials, and methods need to follow, definition, characteristics i.e., on demand capabilities, broad network access, resource pooling, rapid elasticity, measured service, self healing. She explained briefly about three types of services such as Paas, SAAS, IAAS and its deployment models. She also narrated the areas in which the clouding can be used in libraries.

J Sobha Rani presented paper entitled Use and Users Satisfaction on Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) Service among the Teaching Faculty of SreeVidyanikethan Engineering College: A Survey. She mentioned that the use and user satisfaction in OPACs by faculty members of Sri Vidyaniketan Engineering colleges is high. However the research scholars need more awareness of search techniques need for finding library resources.

Resolutions

Following resolutions were suggested and recommended after threadbare discussions, the panel of experts unanimously

- In view of the importance of present electronic/digital environment it is recommended that academic libraries need to build required quantum of electronic/digital resources to serve the students and research scholars and satisfy the users' expectations successfully. In this scenario, it is suggested that academic libraries especially college libraries need to explore the access to N-LIST services offered by the INFLIBNET to augment the e-book library collection.
- It is also recommended to have specialised collections in the colleges with reference to user career.
- It is also suggested to improve the ICT infrastructure and facilities in the colleges for wider access to online resources subscribed.
- It is also suggested that the to automate and digitalize the library in house operations using open source softwares like KOHA, D-Space, Drupal etc,.
- It is recommended to have every academic library a separate website / portal using Drupal and Wordpress for creating an awareness about library resources and services provided both physical and online.
- It is also resolved in the seminar minutes, Government may take initiation fill up the librarian vacancies in Schools, Junior Colleges and Degree Colleges along with ICT infrastructure
- Annual maintenance budget may be release to all libraries in Government Degree Colleges
