



Report on Leprosy Awareness Program on 30.10.2025

On 30th January 2025, the Health Care Center of SVA Government College, Srikalahasti organized a **Leprosy Awareness Program** and invited DPMO, PHC doctors to the college. The event aimed to educate students about leprosy, its symptoms, prevention and the importance of early treatment to eliminate stigma associated with the disease.
